

# Expectations of *GOLD* Leader Mentors

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## Leader Mentors Are:

- \* Volunteers supporting the GOLD program
- \* Role models for other student leaders and campus organizations
- \* A resource of information on campus activities and organizations
- \* Able to help students make connections to get involved and practice leadership
- \* Continually developing leadership skills
- \* Inquisitive and willing to learn leadership concepts and theories
- \* Engaged citizens of the campus and community

## Leader Mentors Do:

- \* Show up on time and work three office hours each week
- \* Participate in weekly staff meetings on Wednesdays 5:00-6:00 pm
- \* Serve as a liaison with a specific group of student organizations
- \* Develop and present interactive leadership workshops
- \* Market the Cocurricular Transcript to students and promote student use of the GOLD Leadership Center
- \* Maintain and use the GOLD Leadership Center Resource Library
- \* Participate in GOLD workshops and the Leadership Certificate Program
- \* Serve as a GOLD representative at workshops to help with promotion, distribute nametags, check rooms and ensure set up is complete, distribute materials to participants, introduce speakers, and collect evaluation forms.
- \* Assume responsibility for one major on-going task: civic engagement initiatives, distribution of promotional materials, marketing of the Leadership Certificate Program, general promotion & publicity for GOLD, promotion of the cocurricular involvement transcript, website information & technology, resource library, program development, leadership training workshops, and recruitment & training.
